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NOTES FOR COMPLETING THE REQUEST FOR CALL SIGN/MMSI FORM

1. APPLICANT'S DETAILS

Insert the details of the applicant or the owner of the vessel.

2. VESSEL/RADIO DETAILS

Class of vessel may be either Fishing, Cargo, Passenger/Cruise or Yacht. Please specify if other.

3. REQUEST

The request could be for either:

- A Call Sign;
- A Call Sign and an MMSI number.

The MMSI number request must only be for programming of Digital Selective Calling (DSC) units, and in the absence of an already assigned MMSI obtained via EPIRB registration or Inmarsat terminal activation. The same MMSI shall be used for EPIRB registration, Inmarsat activation and programming of DSC units. Therefore, if an MMSI has already been obtained via Inmarsat terminal activation or EPIRB registration then the same MMSI must be used to program the DSC, and no request should be initiated via this form. MMSI used for EPIRB registration follows a separate procedure with SMSA, and is done via a separate EPIRB registration form. The EPIRB registration form is obtained from SMSA.

MMSI for Inmarsat activation are obtained via the Point of Service Activation (PSA). Consequently, if a vessel has DSC, EPIRB and Inmarsat equipment on board, then applicant should as far as possible activate their Inmarsat terminals first to obtain their MMSI through the PSA. Else it must be indicated during EPIRB registration whether there are Inmarsat terminals located on board the vessel or not.
