

## **CARGO VESSEL REGISTRATION UNDER SEYCHELLES FLAG**

### **PROVISIONAL AND PERMANENT REGISTRATION**

1. Fill in in Application Form RS01 (Form attached or can be obtained from Ship Registration office)
2. Declaration of ownership (**must have the signatories and stamp of the Notary Agents, Lawyer or the Company Stamp**)
3. Certificate of Incorporation (IBC)(if applicable) and Memorandum and Articles of Association
4. Bill of Sale
5. Builder's Certificate
6. Copy of Insurance Certificate
7. Deletion Certificate (**from previous Flag State and not applicable for newly constructed vessels**)
8. Copy of International Tonnage Certificate
9. Copy of **ALL STATUTORY AND CLASS CERTIFICATES**
10. Copy of Previous Certificate of Registry
11. Minimum Safety Manning Certificate (**if applicable**)
12. Owner to apply for Radio License and from Seychelles Licensing Authority.
13. Fill in the form for Call Sign/MMSI number
14. Fill in the 406 MHz EPIRB Registration Form
15. Mortgage if any
16. Vessel to be surveyed for its Seaworthiness Certificate by a Seychelles Maritime Safety Administration surveyor before registration and/or approved Class Society.

17. A photo of vessel (colour) A4 size

**(Every year there is an annual fee payable before  
the 31st January of each year)**

**NOTE:** To register any vessel under the Seychelles Flag one must be either a Seychellois citizen or form an IBC company.

***If present owner does not have the Deletion Certificate from the present country of registration, then the owner will be issued with a Provisional Registry Certificate valid for 90 days. Once he receives the deletion certificate he is to present it to the ship registration officer who will then issue him with a permanent Certificate of Registry.***
