

## INTERNATIONAL YACHT REGISTRATION UNDER SEYCHELLES FLAG

1. Complete the Application Form for the Registration of the Yacht (**Form RS01A**) (Form Attached)
2. Complete the Declaration of Ownership (**must have the signatories and stamp of the Notary Agents, Lawyer**) (Form Attached)
3. Provide copy of Certificate of Incorporation (**IBC/FSA**)
4. Copy of Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association
5. If older than 15 years age then will be subjected to conditional survey by SMSA for seaworthiness first. ( For vessels being refurbished: Surveyor should be present to check the progress of the refurbishment of vessels)
6. Copy of previous Certificate of Registration
7. Builder's Certificate
8. Deletion Certificate (**only if vessel has been previously registered and NOT applicable to newly constructed vessels**)
9. Bill of Sale
10. Mortgage if any
11. Proof of the authorized person to sign on behalf of the owner
12. Vessel to be surveyed for its seaworthiness by SMSA or SMSA approved surveyor before registration
13. A photo of the Yacht (colour)
14. Complete the Request for Call Sign/MMSI Form

15. Complete the Radio Application Form (Form Attached) (or can be obtained from Seychelles Licensing Authority) and bring it to SLA for payment. **Note: Vessel need to be registered before SLA can issue the Radio License.**
  
16. Upon payment of the Registration Fees, together with the above mentioned documents the vessel can be registered

## REGISTRATION FEES

Initial Registration Fees	US\$ 500
Annual Tonnage Fees	US\$ 300
Certificate of Registry	US\$ 150 <b>(valid for 5 years)</b>
Telecommunication License	US\$ 166

**(Every year there is an annual tonnage fee of US\$ 300 payable before the 31<sup>st</sup> January of each year)**

**NOTE: if present owner(s) does not have the Deletion Certificate from the present country of registration, then the owner will be issued with a Provisional Yacht Registry Certificate valid for 90 days. Once he/she receives the deletion certificate he is to present it to the ship registration officer who will then issued with a permanent yacht Registry Certificate.**
